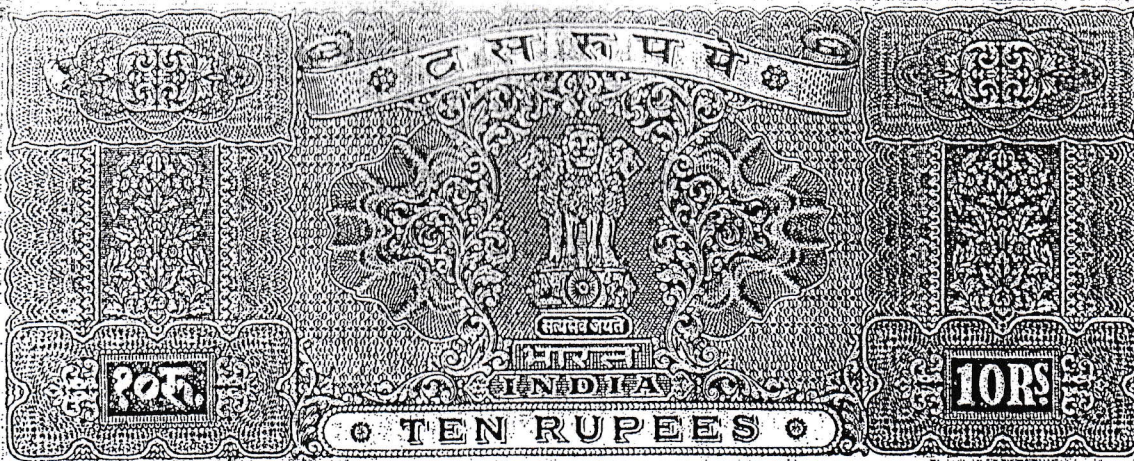

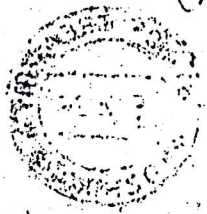

AND WHEREAS the DONORS and the trustees deem it desirable to register the Trust deed under the Indian Registration Act reciting the said objects and terms and incorporating the above said amendment and it is therefore necessary for the Donors and the Trustees to execute this Deed of Trust on the date above mentioned.

NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSES:

1. As narrated above the Donors had donated the sum of Rs. Five hundred to the Trustees in order to carry on and fulfil the objects of the trust.

2. The Objects of the Trust Are:

(a) To work for the educational, social, cultural and economic advancement of the people of India.

(b) To establish and run an Orphanage in the District of Calicut and in such other places as may be decided by the Trustees to protect orphans and under privileged children, to establish and manage institutions and Schemes, specially for the benefit of women, children, destitutes, and the handicapped, and to establish schools, Hostels, and other institutions to fulfil the multi dimensional needs and requirements.

(c) To establish schools, Colleges, Industrial Training Centres, Poly Technics, Training Schools and similiar institutions to promote the technical and general education among the Scheduled Castes, scheduled Tribes and other socially backward classes.

(d) To establish Hospitals, Dispensaries, Clinics and Nursing Homes to cater to the medical needs of the poor and the under privileged and to establish rehabilitation centres for the handicapped.

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(e) To establish Libraries and Recreation Centres.

(f) To organise, camps, courses, literacy programmes, seminars and symposium.

(g) To publish and propogate books, periodicals and journals as deemed useful by the Trust for the achievement of the objectives of the Trust.

(h) To promote and establish industries, production units and service centres with a view to improving the employment opportunities of the rural population and without profit motive.


(i) To institute and assist in the promotion of huminitarian and philanthropic projects.

(j) To help and assist all efforts to protect and safeguard the constitutional and legal rights of the religious and linguistic minorities.

(k) To receive aids and loans from Central and State Governments, Semi.Governmental bodies, Corporations, Khadi and village Industries Department and other bodies, institutions and individuals.

(l) To expend all contributed and incidental income of the trust accruing from time to time without profit motive for the development of the Trust or as desired fit to grant by the Trustees in the path of the goals and in keeping with the aim and objects mentioned in the deed.


(m) To Co.operate with other missionary and charitable organisations and institutions for the attainment of the goals of the trust and to do such other acts, deeds and things as are conducive to promote, encourage or fulfil the above mentioned aims and objectives.

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3. The foregoing purposes shall be served in the order of their importance, need propriety and financial capacity as determined by the Trustees after paying the Government revenue, taxes, cesses, rates and all expenses of collection and management.
4. The Trustees shall govern, manage and administer the Trust and Trust properties in the best interest of the Trust and its beneficiaries, discharge the duties with due care and ability and fulfil the purpose herein described with utmost sincerity. They shall perform their duties solely for the pleasure of God.
5. The office of the Trust shall be at Chathamangalam in Kozhikode Taluk Kozhikode District. But the Trustees shall have the power to shift the office to any other place in India or open Sub-offices in such places as are deemed fit by the Trustees for the smooth functioning of the Trust.
6. If any vacancy arises in the Board of Trustees on account of the death, or incapacity or dismissal under clause 29 of this deed, the remaining Trustees may nominate with the approval ^{of} 75% of the existing strength and appoint any person as Trustee or Trustees in the vacancy or vacancies so arising. The Trustees shall have the power to include more Trustees and enlarge the Board of Trustees with the approval of 75% of the existing strength. However the number of the Trustees shall be limited to 13.
7. Any question arising in the administration of the Trust shall be decided by the majority of the Trustees acting for the time being. The chairman shall have a casting vote in case of tie.



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8. For the convenient management of the affairs of the Trust, the Trustees shall elect one among them as Executive Secretary of the Trust either in a honorary capacity or on payment of remuneration.

9.(a) The Trustees, if and when deemed fit by them, shall delegate their responsibility, rights and powers as defined in the clauses of this Deed to an Executive Committee elected from among them of not more than six members including chairman and the Executive Secretary and headed by the Chairman by a 3/4th majority of the total strength. The Trustees shall have the right to suspend or terminate the said Executive Committee at any time of their choice by the same majority and fulfilling the provisions of this deed for the conduct of meetings of the Trustees.

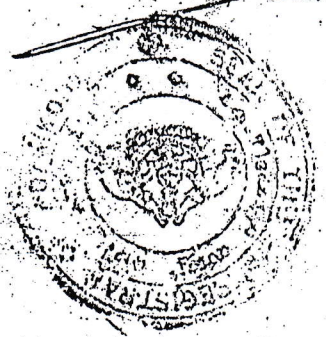
(b) The Trustees if and when deemed fit by them shall delegate their responsibility, power and privilages as defined in the clauses of this deed to Subcommittee elected from among them or from outside to organise and implement individual programmes, projects and plans of the Trust as defined in the objects of the Trust. The Trustees shall have the right to limit and expand the membership of such committees and to suspend and terminate such committees at any time by them by a majority of the meeting of the Trustees. However, the Chairman and the Executive Secretary can, subject to ratification by the Board suspend or terminate a subcommittee if it is found emergent.

10. The meeting of the Executive Committee shall be convened by the Chairman and / or the Executive Secretary or any other member of the Executive Committee

authorised in this behalf by the committee on giving at least 7 days notice to all the members. The Chairman and / or the Executive Secretary shall be bound to convene a meeting of the Executive Committee if required to do so by notice specifying the matter sought to be discussed and signed by a majority of the total members of the Executive Committee within five days of receipt of such notice. If the managing trustee and / or Executive Secretary fails to convene such meeting, the requisitionists themselves shall convene a meeting of the Executive committee and such meeting shall be deemed to have been properly convened.


11. After defraying all necessary expenses incurred in the realisation of the income of the subject matter of the Trust, the balance of the income shall be deposited in a Nationalised or scheduled Bank.

12. Mr. V. MOHAMMED shall be the first Chairman of the Trust for a period of 5 years, Thereafter the Trustees may elect one among them as the Chairman for the same period.

13. The Chairman shall preside over the meetings of the Trustees and shall manage the affairs of the Trust subject to the approval of the Trustees. He shall co.ordinate the work of the Trust in consultation with the Trustees.

14. Mr. C.T. ABDURAHIMAN shall be the Executive Secretary of the Trust for a period of 5 years. Thereafter the Trustees may elect one among them as the Executive Secretary for the same period.

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15.(a) The Executive Secretary shall be the Principal Executive Officer of the Trust and shall take appropriate steps to carry out all decisions of the meeting of the Trustees.

(b) He shall carry on the correspondence on behalf of the Trust.

(c) He shall convene all meetings of the Trustees and maintain a record of the minutes of all such meetings

(d) He shall be the custodian of all the records and properties of the Trust and shall attend to all matters of general administration in accordance with the directions of the Board of Trustees and keep true and proper accounts of the transactions of the Trust.

(e) He shall receive and disburse cash and shall retain with him necessary cash to meet day to day expenses. This amount to be so retained shall be fixed by the Board of Trustees from time to time.

(f) The Executive Secretary shall represent the Trust in all actions civil, criminal and governmental. However it is with in his right to nominate any Trustee or Trustees to act on his behalf for this purpose in cases of specified undertaking or for a fixed period of time.

(g) He shall fulfil all other functions as needed for the smooth functioning of the Trust as decided by the Trustees.

16. The Bank account of the Trust shall be operated jointly by the Chairman of the Trustees and the

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Executive Secretary. But they shall not draw any amount more than the annual budgetary estimate without the special sanction of the Trustees.

17. The meeting of the Trustees shall be convened either by the Chairman or the Executive Secretary or by both or any other Trustee authorised in this behalf by the Board of Trustees, on giving at least three days' notice to all the Trustees. The Chairman and / or the Executive Secretary shall be bound to convene a meeting of the Trustees if required to do so by notice signed by not less than one third of the total members of the board of Trustees within seven days of receipt of such notice. Such notice shall specify the matters ought to be discussed in the meeting.

18. If the chairman and / or the Executive Secretary fails to convene a meeting as aforesaid within the stipulated time, the requisitionists themselves shall convene a meeting of the Trustees and such meeting shall be deemed to have been properly convened.

19. The Trustees shall meet at least once in six months and the Trustees attending the meeting shall be eligible for sitting allowance, batta or travelling allowances at such rates as may be fixed by the Board of Trustees from time to time. The Secretary shall submit before the Board in every sitting the working report of the Trust and the budget in the primary session of a year.

20. The Board of Trustees shall consider and adopt a budget annually or biannually as is decided upon by them.

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
21. The quorum of the meeting of the Board of Trustees the Executive Committee shall be 50%. In case any meeting of the Trustees is adjourned for want of quorum, the next meeting shall be convened within 15 days of such adjournment and the said meeting shall be proceeded with even if there is no quorum.

22. The Board of Trustees shall appoint the necessary staff, employees and other officials for the functioning of the Trust and shall have the power to decide all matters relating to such appointments and other relevant factors in connection therewith.

23. The Board of Trustees shall have power to accept the trustee ship or management of any other trust, wakf, association, organization or endowment and such Trust, wakf, association, organization or endowment shall be administrated in consonance with the provisions of this deed.

24. The Board of Trustees shall have power to accept of receive all loans, endowments, gifts, grants or donations, zakat, movable or immovable properties made to this Trust by assignment, or otherwise by individuals, groups, families, organizations or associations, whether incorporated or not or by any Government and all such endowments gifts, grants, donations or Zakat shall become the property of the Trust and shall be administered for pursuing the aims and objectives of this trust and in accordance with the provisions of this Deed.

25. The Trustees shall not have power to sell or otherwise dispose of the properties of the Trust or any other party thereof, except in case of absolute necessity or for purchasing properties more useful and / or beneficial to the Trust and except with the approval of at least 75% of the existing Trustees. The Trustees shall however, have the power to pawn, pledge or mortgage the Trust properties in order to raise funds or loans to carry out the objectives of the Trust. No such pawns, pledge or mortgage shall be valid unless made with the approval of at least 75% of the existing Trustees.

26. The Trustees may by a majority 75% frame necessary rules of its activities without being repugnant to the provisions of this deed, such rules or regulations may be amended added to or altered with the approval of 75% of the existing Trustees.

27. The Trustees shall have the powers to amend, delete or add to the existing provisions of this deed without being repugnant to the charitable and social service nature of this deed. Such amendments, deletions and additions shall however be subject to the approval of the 75% of the existing Trustees. Every such amendments should have the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax, Cochin.

28. The accounts of the Trust shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant or any other person appointed by the trustees in this behalf.

29. Any Trustee or Trustees who act or do anything detrimental to the interest of the Trust or lays himself open to the charge of persistent neglect may be dismissed

by the Board of Trustees at a meeting of the Trustees specially convened for this purpose and by a Resolution approved by 75% of the total members of the Trustees.

30. The Trust shall be an irrevocable Trust. But the Board of Trustees shall with the approval of at least 75% of its members have the power to associate or amalgamate with other Trust constituted for purposes similar to this.

31. All institutions run and managed by the Trust and its Sub committees being managed by the minority committee are eligible to get protection as envisaged in Article 31 of the Indian Constitution.


32. In all other matters not specifically provided for herein, the Trustees shall function in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Trust Act.

33. The Donors have invested the Trustees jointly with themselves with the ownership and possession of the subject matter of the Trust who have agreed to accept the Trust.

34. In case of dissolution of the Trust the assets as well as the income of the trust shall be assigned either to a charitable trust / Institution having similar objects or to the Government.

The assets of the trust is Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) donated by Donors as aforesaid.



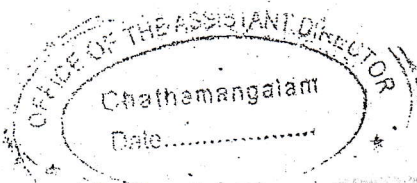


